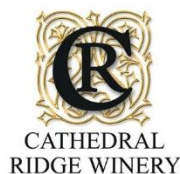

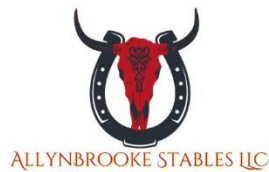

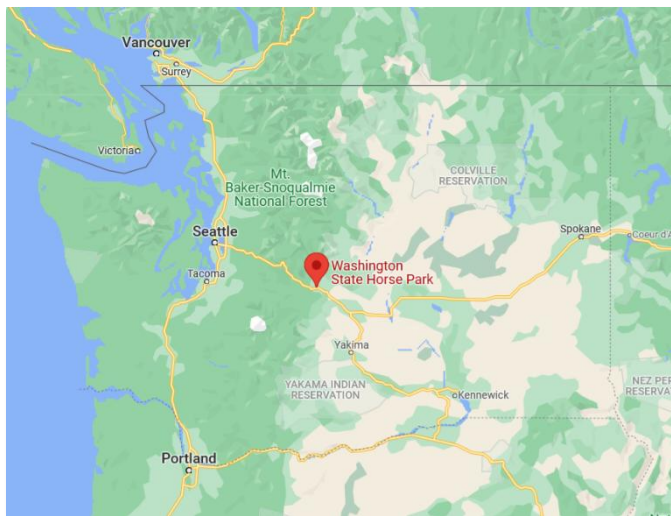

The Horse Park is conveniently located off Interstate 90 in Cle Elum, Washington, approximately 80 miles from Seattle.

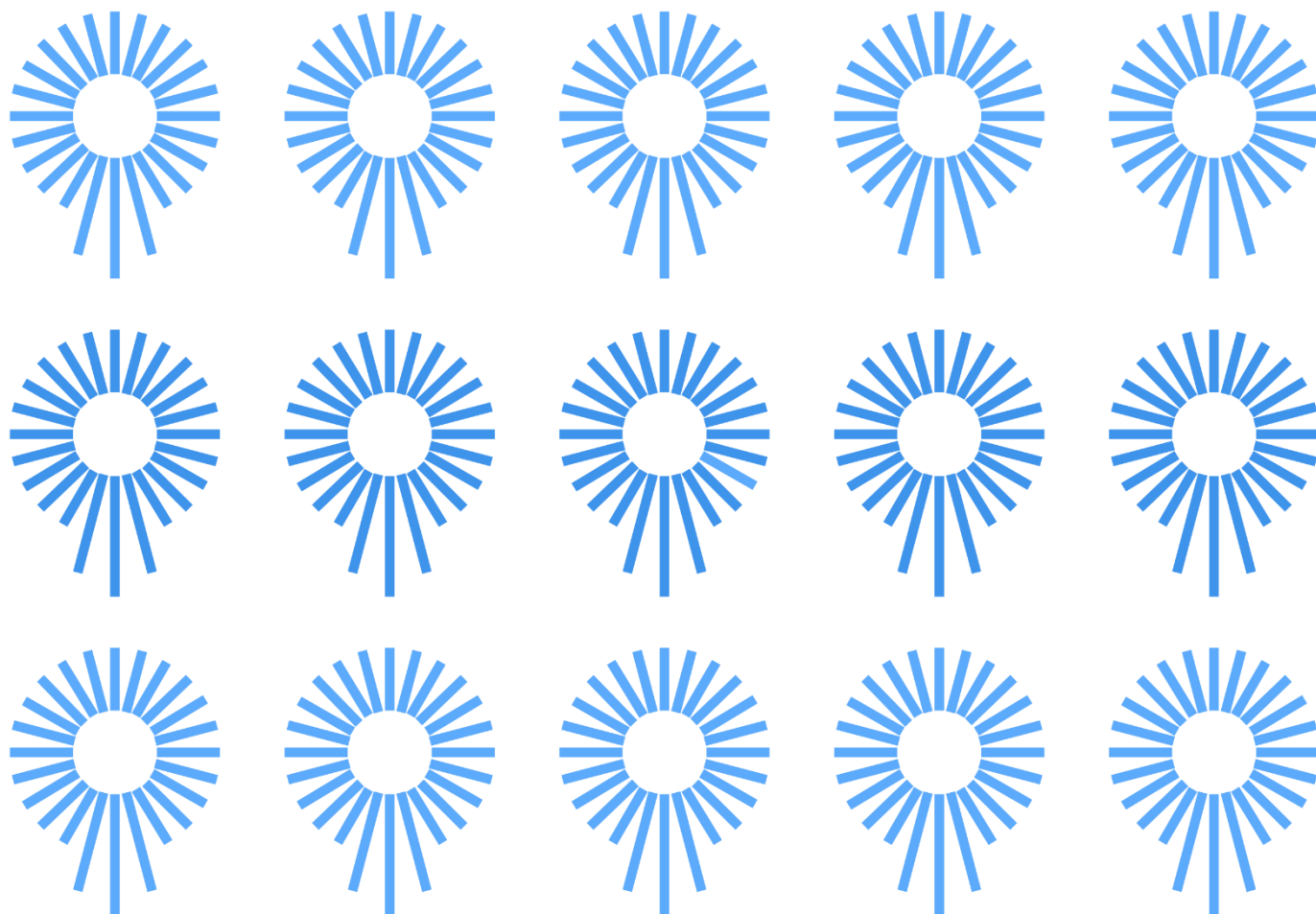
From I90 Westbound:

Continue on Douglas Munro Blvd

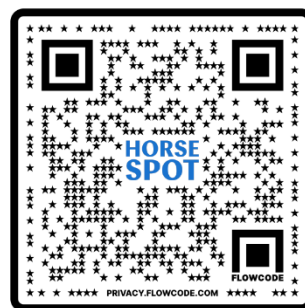

Choices are not guaranteed, and no requests are final until you receive emailed confirmation from the Show Office and render payment, if required. For cancellations, please see [Cancellations & Refunds](#), page 17.

All sites are assigned by Cascade Horse Shows and will be shared with you upon confirmation. Upon arrival, please find your site at the welcome center or Show Office should you need assistance. An RV Pass must be procured at the Show Office and prominently displayed. Full hookups include sewage + utilities. Partial hookups include utilities. Pump outs available (requires signup in the Show Office). Hookups with utilities may include 15-amp, 30-amp, or 50-amp power (varies by site). Availability of 50-amp hookups is limited. All sites have potable water. Charges apply whether hooked up to utilities or not.

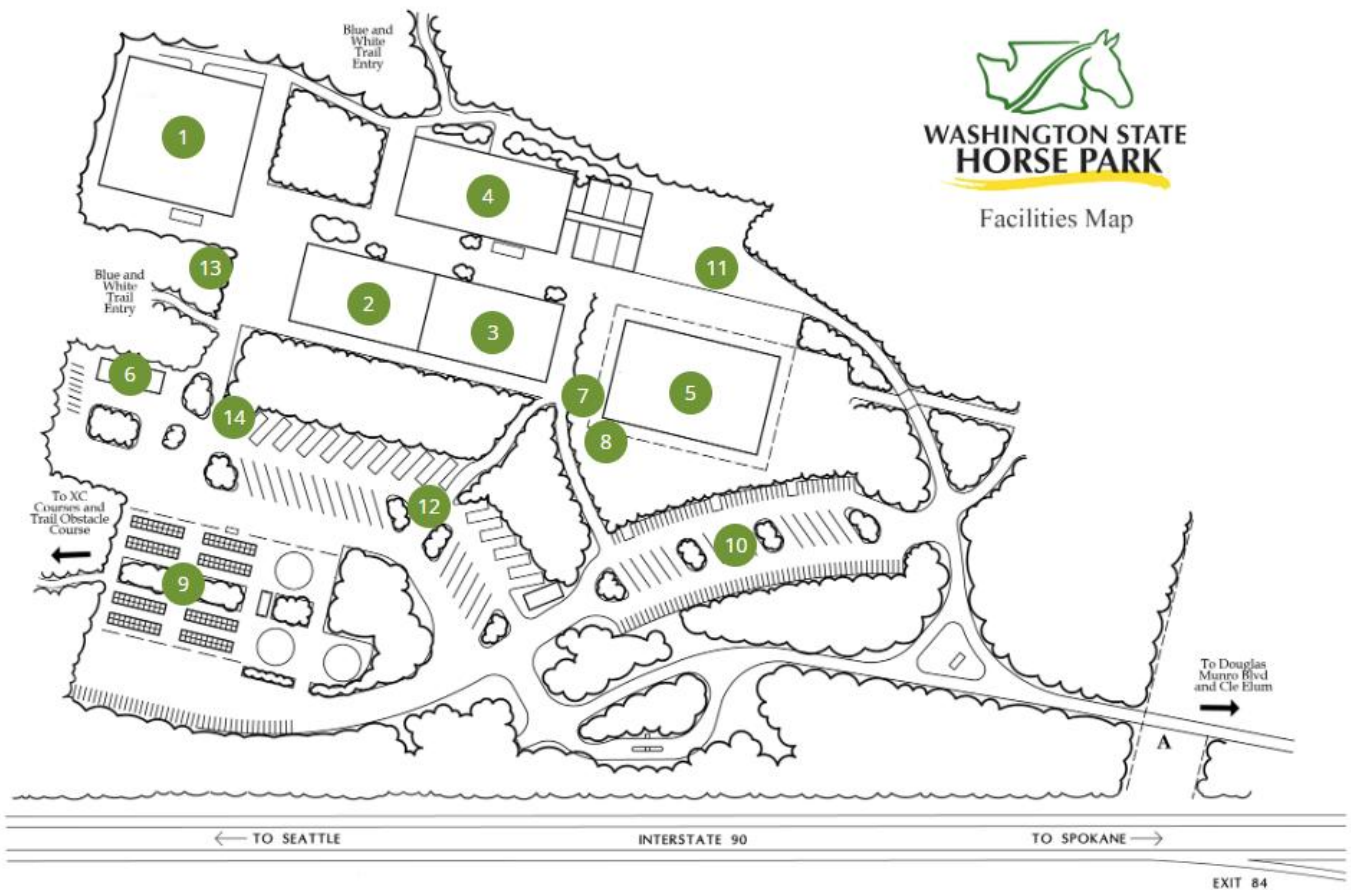

IMPORTANT POLICIES OF THE SHOW

STALL RESERVATIONS

Trainers or their authorized agents, or individual exhibitors not affiliated with a trainer, must use our online [Stall Reservation form](#) to reserve stalls in advance of our shows. Entries cannot be accepted without stall reservations. We will confirm your reservation within 7 business days of receiving your form. In the case that stalls sell out prior to the close of entries, we will add your reservations to our waitlist.

You can change your counts by notifying us via email at office@cascadehorsheshows.com or text at 360.573.4360, *however*, your counts will be locked-in after the show scratch / cancellation deadline (see below).

Confirming your counts: When the scratch deadline is approaching, we will contact you at least 72 hours in advance to confirm your final stall count. Stalls you confirm past the scratch deadline will be *final* regardless of whether you have submitted entries, so please only reserve stalls you are confident you will use. If we do not hear back from you at this stage, your stalls will be released to others on the waitlist.

Changes past this deadline: If your needs change past this deadline, you can work with other trainers to take your confirmed stalls—provided you notify us via email. All parties—i.e., you and the other trainer(s)—must be included on this communication to us. You must give us notice of any stall exchanges at least 10 days prior to the start of the show to have this reflected on the stabling chart. In the unlikely case of a misunderstanding between trainers as to who is paying for exchanged stalls, we must hold the trainer who made the original reservation responsible for the stalls.

If something does change, please reach out to us as soon as possible. While the above is our formal policy, with enough notice we will always try to work with you while maintaining a fair approach for all competitors.

CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

If circumstances change and you will no longer be able to attend the show, please communicate any desired changes promptly. This helps us accommodate as many competitors as possible.

Show Scratches and Cancellations: The deadline for show cancellations and scratches without penalty will be the *earliest* of these two dates:

- The published close of entry date for the show
- A date we officially announce that is approximately 6 weeks prior to the show (in the event the show sells out early)

Up until this deadline, you may make changes to or cancel your entries or their associated stall reservations and RV site requests without penalty. Any deposits paid with entries made prior to the scratch deadline will be fully refunded.

After this deadline, you are fully responsible for any stall fees due for your reserved stalls (see above) in addition to office fees due, if any. Refunds for RV sites with hookups are offered prior to the entry close date provided we can resell the space. RV sites are non-refundable past close of entries.

Changes Past the Close of Entries: A \$50 office fee per horse will apply to all entries, scratches and substitutions made after the close of entries. Please note that after a horse has been checked in, there are no refunds of stalls, nomination fees, feed and hay, bedding, RV reservations, schooling fees, office fees, non-showing horse fees, manure and garbage disposal fees or any completed classes.

Refunds: Any refunds due will be credited to your card or mailed to you within 3 weeks following the show.

How to Request Changes: Please communicate your requests to the Show Office promptly at office@cascadehorsheshows.com.

Illness or Injury During the Competition: After the competition starts, if you are unable to compete due to an illness or injury, your remaining class fees will be refunded upon presentation of a doctor's certificate. Stall and other fees will not be refunded. A \$50 office charge will apply.

ADDITIONAL POLICIES

Adds & Scratches Due By 4:00 pm Daily

All changes for the next day, including adds and scratches, must be made by 4:00 pm each day in the office or on [horseshowing.com](https://www.horseshowing.com). This allows the next day's schedule to be created with class counts and times and made available to everyone in a timely manner.

Day-of Adds

If wanting to add a class on the same day, approval will be based on schedule availability and management discretion. We cannot guarantee acceptance, and you may be put on the ring wait list. If accepted, day-of adds will be assessed a \$10 per class fee. Enter your classes by 4:00 pm the day prior to avoid the \$10 add fee. See our [full policy](#) on page 21.

Canceling And Combining of Classes

Classes with fewer entries than the minimums may be either canceled or combined with other classes, at management's discretion.

Posted Ring Schedule

The most accurate estimation of the daily ring schedules will be completed after adds and scratches have been entered. We strive to post this schedule by 7:00 pm the day prior. The schedule can be found at our [Competitor Resources page](#).

US EQUESTRIAN MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Cascade Horse Shows competitions are conducted under current U.S. Equestrian and USHJA rules and are U.S. Equestrian, USHJA, USHJA Zone 9, WSHJA, and OHJA approved.

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

ENTRIES

Enter online only via [Horse Spot](#).

Each show has a published close of entries date after which refunds are limited. However, you may enter the shows at any time assuming space availability.

All entries require a Competition Deposit equivalent to the cost of a stall plus a \$50 fee. This deposit will be fully credited to your final show bill upon checkout if entries are received prior to the close of entries date. If your entries are received after the close of entries date, the \$50 per entry fee is forfeited.

SCRATCH DEADLINE

The deadline for refunds in the event of show cancellations or scratches will be the *earliest* of these two dates:

- The published close of entry date for the show
- A date that we publicly announce that is approximately 6 weeks prior to the show if the show sells out early

Refunds for show entries or reserved stalls are not possible for any reason after this deadline. Please contact the Show Office to request refunds.

STALL RESERVATIONS

Trainers or their authorized agents, or individual exhibitors not affiliated with a trainer, may use our online [Stall Reservation form](#) to reserve stalls in advance of our shows. Please see our full [Stall Reservation policy](#) on page 16.

PAYMENT

Pay by check, cash, money order, VISA, MasterCard, Discover, American Express credit or debit card. A valid form of payment must be presented upon check-in at the show. All credit and debit card payments are subject to a 4% convenience fee.

Canadian Exhibitor entries must be paid by draft payable in US funds or check on Canadian US dollar account or credit card. Canadian checks with US FUNDS written on the face of the check cannot be accepted.

All checks returned by the bank incur a fee of \$50. To retain entries, the fees and penalty must be paid by before 4pm the day before the Show starts. In the event a check is returned after the completion of the show, it will be handled in accordance with US EQUESTRIAN GR913.

Competitors who do not come into the office to close out at the end of the show forfeit the right to adjustments on any show charges. Final balances will be automatically charged to the payment method on file.

TRAINER SPLITS

Trainers having accounts with Cascade Horse Shows may choose to add their show fees and charges to their "trainer splits" to have these charges distributed amongst their clients. Trainers have until 5:00pm Friday of the show to inform the Show Office which charges will be distributed to which clients. It is fully and solely the trainer's responsibility to indicate which items are applicable to the split and to which clients they should be applied. *Exhibitors:* By submitting an entry form, you acknowledge that you fully accept responsibility for the costs assigned to you by your trainer for the show that you are entering.

SUBSTITUTIONS

A new horse may be substituted for a scratched horse. There will be a \$50 office charge for substitutions made after the close of entries.

SHOW SCRATCH and REFUNDS

Refer to [Cancellations & Refunds](#) on page 17.

REQUIRED CREDENTIALS

Exhibitors entering rated competition must present copies of the following current credentials to the horse show: US EQUESTRIAN/USHJA/EC membership card; US EQUESTRIAN/USHJA Amateur certification; US EQUESTRIAN/USHJA Large, Small, Junior Hunter and Pony measurement card; USHJA/EC horse recording card or ID number. If measurement cards are not available, measurement will be required. Check in the Show Office for measurement times and dates.

USHJA HORSE REGISTRATIONS

All horses competing in licensed competitions with Hunter, Hunter Breeding, Jumper and/or Hunt Seat Equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9) must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. Not required for Opportunity and Outreach classes.

HORSE MICROCHIP

Note: An ISO 11784/11785 compliant chip is required for entry into ALL USHJA rated hunter/jumper competitions starting with the 2019 season.

STATEMENT OF HORSE HEALTH / VACCINATIONS

Per GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule: At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Competitors may be asked to provide proof of vaccination upon check-in or prior to entering the property.

SAFE SPORT

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

COMPETITION OFFICE HOURS

Day preceding show: 10:00am-5:00pm. Days of show: 7am-5pm or 30 minutes after the last regular class completes whichever is later. Special classes are excluded. Regardless of closing time all next day class adds are due by 4:00pm.

PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO

Photography and video may be captured for personal use. Professional photography or video captured for purposes of sale or free distribution to Cascade Horse Shows exhibitors (now or in the future) is strictly prohibited except by officially licensed photographers. Professional photographers who are not officially licensed may apply for a weekly show pass (available for a fee by contacting office@cascadehorsheshows.com) and agree to abide by the rules set forth therein. Failure to abide by the rules may result in a request to leave the property.

ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

Arrivals: You may arrive as early as two days prior to the start of competition. For example, a Wednesday competition start with a Tuesday warm-up day means you may move in on Monday beginning at noon. You may arrive later if you like. For approval to arrive earlier than noon two days before competition start, contact the Show Office at office@cascadehorsheshows.com. Early arrivals incur a per-night fee per-stall and per-RV, as applies.

Departures: Plan to depart Stabling and RV locations by 7pm Sunday or pre-pay with the Show Office to stay over Sunday night. The fee is \$50 per horse stall, and you must vacate by 8am on Monday morning. On Sunday night there will be a 10pm stabling 'lights out'. Sunday night RV stays incur a 'per night' RV fee.

STABLING

Stalls with doors are provided; dimensions are 10'x10'. 160 have mats; the remaining have dirt/gravel floors. Requests for specific stalls or stall locations will be considered on an individual basis. Preference given to horses showing multiple weeks and to sponsors. Portable stalls, with doors, are provided. Bales of shavings will be available by pre-order on entry form and/or during the show by request at the Competition Office. Straw is not permitted.

In cases of high demand, management reserves the right to cap how many non-horse stalls are sold, and a ratio of horse stalls to non-horse stalls may be put into effect.

Stalls must be cleaned daily. Dirty bedding must be placed in areas provided. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning their own stalls and must provide their own feed and buckets. A \$60 manure disposal and garbage fee will be assessed for all stalls. No staples, nails, cutting stalls or removal of top doors permitted. Stabling damage fees will be assessed by the WSHP as follows: Panels – \$100 portable stall, \$200 permanent stall; Stall metal framework - \$200; light cords \$150; Roof Tarps – actual repair/replacement costs. Trash cans and bags will be provided on move out days.

SHARPS CONTAINERS

Sharps containers will be available at the end of each barn aisle way. Please be aware Competition Management may fine any individual up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. GR1210.4 If needles are dropped in manure, it cannot be composted.

JUMPER / HUNTER / EQ NOMINATING FEE

Horses or ponies entered in any jumper, hunter or equitation classes pay a Nomination Fee (varies per show). This fee allows entries to add classes before 4:00 pm prior to the day of the class (see next section).

CLASS ADD / SCRATCH POLICY

Adds — Classes may be added up to a day ahead of time at no charge if the Show Office is notified by 4:00pm. Unless otherwise posted, it should be assumed that there are no day-of adds. If wanting to add a class on the same day, approval will be based on schedule availability and management discretion. We cannot guarantee acceptance, and you may be put on the ring wait list. If accepted, day-of adds will be assessed a \$10 per class fee.

Scratches — With the exception of Spotlight classes, if your horse has a written scratch form at the Show Office prior to the start of the class, full class entry fees are refunded minus a \$10 scratch fee. You must scratch your classes BEFORE they start. If you don't scratch them at all or try to scratch them after the class has started, you will be charged the full class entry fee.

SPOTLIGHT CLASS SCRATCH POLICY

Spotlight classes will be assessed a \$25 scratch fee if scratched on the day of the class.

RIDER DID NOT ENTER (RDNE) FEE

It is the responsibility of the competitor and trainer to ensure they have properly entered all classes they intend to compete in. A "ride-did-not-enter" (RDNE) fee of \$25 will be added to the cost of the class for any rounds competed that cannot be supported by office-approved paperwork.

CLASS WAIT LIST POLICY

Be sure to get all entries planned for the next day in by 4pm. If full ring capacity is reached, any entries received for that ring after 4pm, may be put on a wait list. You are encouraged to enter all classes/divisions for the entire show before 5pm on schooling day to ensure entry in those classes/divisions.

US EQUESTRIAN and USHJA FEES

All horses participating in any competition recognized by the US Equestrian Federation incur the following fees: USEF \$23 fee (\$15 of this fee is a Drugs and Medication fee to provide research, inspection, and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs: see GR407.1, .2, and .3); USHJA Fee \$7 (National shows) or \$2 (Regional I shows). An active USEF competing membership is required for all riders, trainers, and coaches (including parents signing entry forms as trainers). If you are not a current USHJA member, a Show Pass fee of \$30 is assessed by the USHJA. These fees will be added to your show account.

MANAGEMENT CLASS CHANGES

Management reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes as appropriate. Notice will be given to exhibitors affected. Management reserves the right to start the first class of any section 30 minutes earlier than the scheduled time. Management reserves the right to change arenas, judges, or class orders to facilitate time, schedule, and conditions.

PRIZE MONEY PAYMENTS

Exhibitors receive prize money within 3 weeks after the horse show. A valid Social Security or Federal tax ID number must be provided. Prize money won by foreign exhibitors is subject to the US Internal Revenue Service regulation requiring sporting events to withhold 30% of prize money unless they have a US Social Security #.

TROPHIES, RIBBONS, PRIZE MONEY SPLITS

Trophy and ribbons will be awarded to eight places in all Hunter and Equitation classes. Unless stated otherwise, Hunter and Hunter Classic prize money will be divided 30%, 25%, 20%, 15%, 10%. The USHJA National Hunter Derby prize money will be divided 30%, 22%, 13%, 8%, 6%, 5%, 4%, 3%, 3%, 2%, 2%, 2%. Trophy and ribbons will be awarded to six places in all Jumper classes. Unless stated otherwise, Jumper prize money will be divided 25%, 23%, 20%, 17%, 15%. The Cascade Welcome and the Luxury DerbyCross™ prize money will be divided 30%, 23%, 15%, 12%, 10%, 10%. The Need for Speed™ Open Jumper will be divided 30%, 20%, 14%, 10%, 8%, 7%, 6%, 5%. The Grand Prix and Mini Prix will be divided 30%, 20%, 15%, 10%, 8%, 6%, 4%, 3%, 2%, 2%.

HUNTER TIES

As stated in [USEF HU154](#), in case of a tie the Championship and/or Reserve is awarded to the horse with the most points over fences. If horses have equal points over fences and no points under saddle, the tied horses will be asked to compete in a hack off (Exception: Green and Young Hunters.) Any competitor may concede and not hack off, or if both competitors agree, break the tie with a coin toss. If horses have an equal number of points over fences, under saddle, and model (i.e., Green Conformation Hunter 3'6" or High-Performance Conformation Hunter) the tie will stand as is and double ribbons will be awarded.

JUMPER TIES

As stated in [USEF IP143](#), Competitors who are tied for first place after the initial round(s) will jump off. Any competitors that compete in the jump off and are still tied for first place shall remain tied. Competitors who are tied for other than first place in all Jumper sections will be placed according to the time taken to complete the first course. Prize money and Championship points shall be combined and divided equally among the tied competitors. Double ribbons will be awarded for division championships. For special classes, the competitors will toss a coin for the ribbon and toss a coin for the special award if any.

JUMPER CLASS SCHEDULE TABLES

Jumper classes not otherwise designated in the class schedules will run as Table II.1, Table II.2.b or Table II.2.c, or Table II.d. Please refer to the daily schedules available in the Competition Office.

STAKE/HANDY HUNTER CLASSES

If a per class entry is offered in a division, horse and rider must have shown in at least one other class in the division to be eligible for the Stake or Handy Hunter Class.

POLING / OFFSETS

Manual poling, or the use of offsets, is prohibited on competition grounds (GR838).

HORSE ILLNESS

In the event of an acute and serious injury or illness of a horse on competition grounds when the owner or trainer of the horse is not present, after reasonable effort to contact that individual has been made, Competition Management, in consultation with a licensed veterinarian, may authorize the provision of emergency veterinary treatment of the horse. If Competition Management authorizes treatment under the provisions of this rule, Competition Management and veterinarian are not responsible for any resulting costs, damages, losses, claims, or actions arising directly from the treatment of the horse.

SCHOOLING AND EXERCISE

Schooling areas are available for use before and during the show. A mandatory schooling fee of \$40 is charged for all horses. Helmets meeting the US Equestrian requirements as well as riding boots must be worn during schooling.

No lungeing is permitted in any of the arenas, including the warm-up rings. Please lunge horses on the designated lungeing pads located on the Horse Park near the west and northeast stalls.

WARM-UP RINGS

During competition days, please cede use of the warm-up rings to riders preparing for upcoming classes. When jumping, standards are cleared with the flags on the right, no reversing of directions. Horses approaching a jump must always be given priority. For your safety and the safety of others, always pass "left shoulder to left shoulder" when traveling in opposite directions in the arena. ARENAS & FOOTING

Hunters: 250' X 255'; Hunters: 150' X 220'; Jumpers (covered): 150' X 300'. All have sand footing.

DOGS

We welcome your dogs at the shows! Keep your dogs and horses safe by always keeping your dogs on leash while on the Horse Park property. We kindly request you pick up after your dog. For their safety, do not let dogs run loose on trails. All dogs are eligible for our Cascade Canine Derby! (Class availability varies by show.)

RVs, MOTORHOMES, TRAILERS, AND CAMPERS

Submit the [RV Site Request form](#) to request your site. RV sites are available by the week only (the night before schooling day through Sunday day only). Additional nights on either end of the reservation may be available for an additional fee with pre-approval. As hookup sites are limited, preference is given for length of stay, sponsors, reservation date, and size of RV. In the event all the hookup sites are reserved, additional requests will be accepted for non-hookup dry-camping sites.

Full payment is required for confirmed sites. Designated trainers having an account with Cascade Horse Shows may choose to add their personal RV site to their show bill to have us do trainer splits. [All other sites](#) must be pre-paid in advance at the time of confirmation. Charges apply to RV site whether hooked to utilities or not.

Upon arrival, an RV Pass must be obtained from Show Office and displayed. Hookup locations are assigned by us—if assigned a site with a hookup, park only in your designated site.

Tent campers must make a [Tent Camping Reservation](#) to camp on the Horse Park grounds. Payment is due with reservation. Upon arrival, camping passes must be obtained from the Parking attendant and prominently displayed. Campers must camp in designated areas only. See the Horse Show Fees, page 13, for fees.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

HELMETS

It is compulsory for all persons at US Equestrian licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secure

SAFETY AND WELFARE

The nearest hospital is [Kittitas Valley Healthcare](#) which is 24 miles from the Washington State Horse Park. The nearest level 1 trauma center is [Harborview Medical Center](#) in Seattle, WA which is 83 miles from the Washington State Horse Park.

DISCRETIONARY POLICY

All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by Show Management whose decision shall be final.

I agree to release WSHP Authority and the individual WSHP Board members and the WSHP Foundation and the individual WSHP Foundation Board Members, their agents, assigns, employees and contractors and members, the City of Cle Elum and Sun Communities (hereinafter collectively referred to as the “Released Parties”) from all claims for money damages or loss for any Harm to me, my injury or death, the injury or death of my child(ren) named below (“Child”) or my horse or for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm, directly or indirectly, resulted from the negligence of the Released Parties.

I agree to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my child or my horse.

Under Washington State law, except as provided in RCW 4.24.540(2), an equine activity sponsor or an equine professional shall not be liable for an injury or the death of a participant engaged in an equine activity, and, except as provided in subsection(s) of this section, no participant nor participant’s representative may maintain an action against or recover from an equine activity sponsor or an equine professional for an injury to or the death of a participant engaged in an equine activity.

I understand these rules and regulations of WSHP will be changed from time to time and I agree to abide by the changed rules. I represent that I and/or my child have the requisite training, coaching and ability to participate safely in the activities we chose to pursue at WSHP.

I hereby give permission to WSHP and those acting with its authority the unrestricted right and permission to use, publish and republish any photographic or video images of me and/or my horse for promotional and marketing purposes of the Horse Park. I also permit the use of any printed material in connection therewith and relinquish any right to review or restrict its use or publication.

I read and understand these Releases, and my handwritten or digital signature below signifies my acceptance of their terms and conditions. I agree these Releases shall remain in full force and effect until they are specifically revoked by me in writing or superseded by new releases issued by the Horse Park and signed by me. For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian (“USEF”) allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and _____ (“USEF Event” or “USEF Events”); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the “Agreement”):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF INHERENT RISKS: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with equine activities, including but not limited to horseback riding and equestrian sport, are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers (“Risks”).

SPECIFICATIONS

Cascade Grands Prix, #1, #4

The Grand Prix held at each Cascade show will be run as a Table II, Sec 2(a) — Time first with a jump off; ties to jump off for first place. Order of go will be drawn by Show Management and posted by 2pm on the day of the class. Prize money will be distributed as 1st 30%, 2nd 20%, 3rd 14%, 4th 10%, 5th 8%, 6th 7%, 7th 6%, 8th 5% unless otherwise stated. Horses and riders must have competed in at least one other class in the competition. Formal attire required; salute to sponsors requested. June shows qualify for the Washington State Elite Jumper Year End Award sponsored by WSHJA.

USHJA National Hunter Derby, #3

The USHJA National Hunter Derby features a two-round format with a minimum of two judges utilizing a numerical system to score competitors in the Classic Hunter Round (first round) on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, and movement. A second round will feature a Handy Hunter course designed to reflect brilliance of pace and handiness. In each round, following the judges' base score, one point will be added for each high-option fence jumped; up to a maximum of four high options may be included. Fences are set at 3' with four high-option fences set at 3'5" (June) or 3'3" (July/September). Prize money will be distributed as: 1st 30%, 2nd 22%, 3rd 13%, 4th 8%, 5th 6%, 6th 5%, 7th 4%, 8th-9th 3%, 10th-12th 2% unless otherwise stated. The top 3 Amateurs/Juniors will also be recognized. Formal attire required; salute to sponsor requested. Full specs can be found in this document and with the United States Hunter Jumper Association.

USHJA National Hunt & Go, #31

To be run in accordance with [USHJA National Hunter Derby specifications](#) in the Hunt & Go format (III.F). The USHJA National Hunt & Go will consist of two (2) phases: one (1) Classic Hunter, and one (1) Handy Hunter. The phases will be jumped consecutively. All participants will complete both the Classic and the Handy portions even if penalties (rails, refusals, etc.) are incurred. Major penalties (falls, 3 refusals, off course, etc.) will be combined from the Classic and Handy rounds and will result in elimination (i.e. a horse who has two refusals in the Classic Round will be eliminated after one refusal in the proceeding Handy Round). Prize money will be distributed as: 1st 30%, 2nd 22%, 3rd 13%, 4th 8%, 5th 6%, 6th 5%, 7th 4%, 8th-9th 3%, 10th-12th 2% unless otherwise stated. Special recognition for the top 3 placing Amateurs/Juniors.

Cascade Welcome, #38

The Cascade Welcome will run as a Table II.2a class at a height of 1.25m. Order of go will be drawn by Show Management and posted by 2pm the day of the class. Prize money will be distributed: 1st 30%, 2nd 23%, 3rd 20%, 4th 15%, 5th 10%, 6th 10% unless otherwise stated.

Luxury DerbyCross™, #7, #25

The DerbyCross™ is a unique combined discipline class that challenges the skills of the rider and horse to perform both the Handy Hunter and Jumper Speed styles in a two-phase round. Fences 1-7 will be the Handy Hunter round, may include some natural fences and a trot fence, and will be judged on performance, hunter pace, style, quality, and handiness. Fences 8-13 will be scored as a Table II.1 jumper round and will include one combination.

Two judges will officiate, judge #1 will award a numeric Handy Hunter score for jumps 1-7, judge #2 will score and time each rider's speed phase. Speed phase points will be awarded 1st 30pts, 2nd 25pts, 3rd 20pts, 4th 18pts, 5th 15pts, 6th 14pts, 7th 13pts, 8th 12pts. The Speed phase points will be added to each competitor's Handy Hunter score and the total will determine the final class placings.

Prize money will be distributed as 1st 30%, 2nd 23%, 3rd 20%, 4th 15%, 5th 10%, 6th 10% unless otherwise stated.

Formal hunter attire and tack required, braiding is optional.

This class may be offered at 3'3" - 1.m or 3' - .90. Please check the schedule for each show for the height offering. This class maybe run in one ring or two, depending on time allowance. The number of obstacles may vary slightly depending on the number of rings used.

If the class is run in two rings, the competitors are not allowed to talk to ANYONE as they walk between rings. And they must cross the start line within 40 seconds of entering the second arena.

Jumpernite Rider Relay, #9

Rotating Pair Relay is a Table III speed round for teams of two. A horse may only compete once in this class, but a rider may compete on more than one horse. The entire course must be jumped twice in the correct order rotating between competitors. The competitor who crossed the start line must jump the first obstacle and the competitor who jumped the last obstacle must cross the finish line. One change mandatory. Competitors change over as often as they wish. A change is obligatory whenever a fault is incurred. Prize money will be distributed as: 1st 30%, 2nd 25%, 3rd 20%, 4th 15%, 5th 10% unless otherwise stated. See USEF rule JP150 #5 for complete rules.

Rosé All Day Amateur Classic, #11

Run in the spirit of a traditional Hunter Hack for all 21 & older amateur riders. A Hunter Hack is a type of English pleasure class where exhibitors in Hunt seat tack and attire perform on the flat at a walk, trot, canter, and hand gallop, and then jump two low fences. For this unique variation, riders may be asked to walk, trot, canter, change direction, sit the trot, halt & back up, and jump a cavalletti line, all while holding a glass of “rosé” wine! Class will be pinned on Judges Score adjusted for the “rosé” left in your glass. Prize money will be distributed as: 1st 50%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20%. The winner also takes home a case of (real) rosé wine with bottles of rosé to 8th place. Traditional attire encouraged; salute to sponsor requested.

Need For Speed™ Open Jumper, #20

The Need for Speed Open Jumper will be run as a Table III speed round, with faults converted into seconds. A time limit of 120 seconds will apply, and faults incurred will be penalized by adding four seconds for each occurrence. This class is offered at 1.10m and 1.20m. Entrants must designate which height they intend to compete in at the time they enter. At the 1.10m height a 2 second handicap will be added to each competitor's time. Prize money will be distributed as: 1st 30%, 2nd 20%, 3rd 14%, 4th 10%, 5th 8%, 6th 7%, 7th 6%, 8th 5% unless otherwise stated. Formal attire required; salute to sponsor requested.

Cascade Equitation Challenge, #22

The top four placing riders from each equitation section at the Cascade Classic and the top four riders from the Pro Equitation on the Flat, #740 (held at the Classic only) are eligible to compete in the Cascade Equitation Challenge. This is a flat equitation class judged in elimination style. Riders will be tested at the judge's discretion. Tests may include riding without stirrups, counter canter, shoulder in, halt, rein back, turn on the forehand, turn on the haunches. The champion will be the final rider on the rail. Formal attire and salute to sponsor appreciated.

USHJA 2'6" Junior/Amateur Hunter Derby, #28

This class will run as a Hunt & Go format with the first half of the course being ridden as a Classic Round and the second half being ridden as a Handy Round. Both phases will be jumped consecutively with no break in pace. Riders may complete both phases even if minor penalties are incurred in the first phase. Major penalties (falls, 2 refusals etc.) will result in elimination. 2'6" section will have 2'9" high options, and 2'9" section will have 3'0" high options. Courses will not have a combination. Scores plus bonus points will be given for each phase and added together to determine total scores. Open to Junior and Amateur riders who will not compete over 2'9" at this show. Riders must jump the highest height they have been competing at.

USHJA Zone 9 Handy Hunter Challenge, #29

To be held as a standalone one round Handy Hunter class. A minimum of ten (10) fences shall be set at 3' in height with spreads not to exceed the fence height. A minimum of 6 entries is required for the class to run and of those, a minimum of 3 rounds must be scored for double points towards USHJA Zone Horse of the Year standings. Open to junior and amateur riders (certification required) whose home Zone of record is Zone 9, and who are Active members of USEF and USHJA before the start of the Handy Hunter Challenge. Horses must be registered with USHJA to participate. Riders may compete more than one horse per Handy Hunter Challenge as long as more than one (1) rider is entered in the Challenge class. Professionals are not eligible to compete in the Handy Hunter Challenge. Formal attire requested but not required.

Cascade Hunter Team Trials, #30

Teams of three riders to jump 7 jumps in a single file line, maintaining equal spacing by riding at an equal pace. The eighth, final fence may be jumped three abreast. Jumps will be set at 2'6" with no combinations. To be judged on team performance, hunter pace, style, and team sportsmanship. Formal attire requested.

Cascade Hunter Classics, #40-52

All Classics are two rounds. The final round over fences of the corresponding section is to count as the first round of the respective Classic. Round 2 to be shown over a course of at least 9 obstacles. Hunter Classic horses or ponies must have competed in at least two hunter classes in the corresponding section to compete. Prize money will be distributed as: 1st 30%, 2nd 25%, 3rd 20%, 4th 15%, 5th 10% unless otherwise stated. Formal attire required; salute to sponsor requested.

Cascade Open Jumper Classics, #71-78

Jumper Classic entries must have entered at least one other class in the corresponding section to compete. Open Jumper Classics are offered at .70m, .80m, .90m and 1.00m. Ribbons to 8th, prize money to 5th: (30%, 25%, 20%, 15%, 10%).

Hobby Horse Classic, #13

Bring your own Hobby Horse or make one at the show! This class is for the under 21 set. Three age groups: 8 & under, 9 – 13, and 14 – 20. Hobby horses will be shown over a hunter style course of ground poles. Horses should have good manners, smooth style and a graceful overall appearance. A smooth canter with lead changes will earn the highest score. The top six may be called back for a Handy Hunter tie-breaker round. Bonus points for the best turned out Hobby Horses. \$10 entry fee (cash or Venmo only).

Rising Stars Leadline, #16

No Fee. Cascade Classic - Week 2 preceding the Barn Pros Grand Prix. Wow the crowd with style and smiles. Prizes to all. Helmet and boots required.

Cascade Canine Derby, #17

A fan-favorite tradition of our Cascade Open and Cascade Finals shows. Open to all dogs of all sizes and breeds. A team event challenging dogs and their humans over a course of 8 obstacles, with high options. \$10 entry fee (cash or Venmo only); sign-up in the Prize Store. Prizes to 6th, smiles for everyone!



USHJA NATIONAL HUNTER DERBY QUICK SPECS

Membership Requirements

1. Riders, owners, and trainers must be a current Active member of USEF and USHJA to participate in this class. (see GR202).
2. Horses and ponies must be registered with USHJA to participate in this class.
3. Exception: Foreign residents and horses and ponies in good standing with their National Federation are eligible to compete in this class but will not receive points unless they follow 1 and 2.
4. USHJA National and Zone HOTY bonus points will only be awarded if the owner is a current Active member of USEF and USHJA and the horse is recorded with USEF and registered with USHJA.
5. Money won will only count for any USHJA National Hunter Derby standings or awards if the rider, owner and trainer are current Active members of USEF and USHJA, and the horse is registered with USHJA.

Course Requirements: Jumps in ALL Rounds

1. Obstacles must simulate those reminiscent of the hunt field and course must offer a variety of Classic jumps with different appearances such as: natural post and rail, stone wall, white board fence or gate, coop, aiken, hedge, oxer, brush, logs, natural foliage.
2. Natural obstacles such as banks and ditches are allowed.
3. A minimum of 2" difference is required for the back element of all oxers.
4. Ground lines are not to exceed 18" in depth from the vertical plane of the jump. For appropriate jumps, no ground line is necessary.
5. The jumpable portion of any fence must be a minimum of 8 feet on its front face
6. The top element of all jumps must be in cups except for walls with movable bricks.
7. Flat cups may only be used for log fences and in accordance with Federation rules.
8. Distances will not be adjusted for ponies.
9. Fence height 3'0"
10. There must be four (4) high option fences set at 3'5". (Hunt and Go format refer to Section III F.1.) If there is a difference in difficulty between any two tracks containing height options, the higher options should include the more inviting, less difficult track.

First Round: Classic Hunter Style Course

1. A minimum of ten obstacles must be offered in the Classic Hunter Round.
2. At least three of the following types of fences must be utilized: natural post and rail, stone wall, white board fence, riviera gate, coop, aiken, hedge, brush or logs.
3. At least one in and out
4. At least one bending line
5. At least one line with an unrelated distance
6. At least one long approach

Second Round: Handy Hunter Course

1. A minimum of eight obstacles must be offered in the Handy Hunter Round.
2. At least three of the following types of fences must be utilized: natural post and rail, stone wall, white board fence, riviera gate, coop, aiken, hedge, brush or logs.
3. The course should simulate riding over hunt country and must have a minimum of two handy options, such as: tight turns, different tracks, clever options for jump approaches, pen type obstacles, hand gallop a jump, trot a lowered obstacle not to exceed 2'6" in height, halt and/or back. Gimmicky options are not appropriate.
4. Unless the prize list states that more than twelve (12) entries are to return for the second round, then only the top twelve (12) horses from the first round, after all ties are broken, are eligible to return for the second round.

Awards and HOTY Points Specifications

1. All riders in the top twelve overall (or their designated representative if not available) must ride for ribbons to receive prize money. Although not required, a show may choose to award separate ribbons for the first round if so stated in the prize list.
2. For National Hunter Derby Zone HOTY points to be awarded, riders must complete a USHJA Exhibitor Declaration Form prior to the conclusion of the competition.
3. Points accrued by horses shown by Professionals may be awarded to the declared Green Hunter 3'0", Green Hunter 3'3", Performance Hunter 3'3", Small Hunter, Young Hunter 5 and under- 2'9", Young Hunter 6 and under- 3', or Young Hunter 7 and under- 3'3".
4. Points accrued by horses shown by Juniors or Amateurs may be awarded to the declared Green Hunter 3'0", Green Hunter 3'3" Performance Hunter 3'3", or the applicable Children's, Pony, Adult Amateur, Amateur Owner 3'3", Small Hunter or Junior Hunter 3'3, Young Hunter 5 and under- 2'9", Young Hunter 6 and under- 3', or Young Hunter 7 and under- 3'3".

Judging System

1. The first round shall be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, and movement. After the judge(s) base score is given, one (1) point will be added for each high option fence jumped. The Option Bonus Score of one additional point must be awarded even if there is a refusal, rail down or loss of good jumping style at that higher height option fence, providing that the horse-and-rider combination does jump the higher height option fence. (Maximum of four points.)
2. The second round shall be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, movement, handiness and brilliance of pace. Handiness is defined as ground saving movement without adversely affecting performance or style. Brilliance of pace is defined as a faster pace than ordinary, without sacrificing performance or style. Handiness is taken into account in the judges' base score. After the judge(s)' base score is given, one (1) point will be added for each high option fence jumped. The Option Bonus Score of one additional point must be awarded even if there is a refusal, rail down or loss of good jumping style at that higher height option fence, providing that the horse-and-rider combination does jump the higher height option fence. (Maximum of four points.)

In accordance with GR1111.4: CA, NV, UT, CO, ND, SD, NE, and Canada are contiguous states.

JUDGING FOR ALL HUNTER AND EQUITATION SECTIONS:

- To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability to count.
- Horses and Ponies are not required to jog for soundness.
- In Equitation: to be judged on performance, style, form and suitability of horse and rider to count

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULT AMATEURS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:

- To be ridden by exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year and who hold a current USEF Amateur certification. Open to horses and ponies.

ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN'S SECTIONS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:

- To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER

Sections offered and requirements: • Adult Amateurs – may be split into three (3) sections. **Cross Entry: Riders:** Amateur Owner Hunter riders may compete on a maximum of one (1) Adult Amateur Hunter horse that they own at the same competition. Riders may not show in any classes in which the fences are 3'9" and over at the same competition. **Horses:** Horses entered in Adult Amateur Hunter sections may not compete in the Amateur Owner Hunter sections at the same competition. **Horse and Rider Combination:** Horse and rider combinations may not cross enter into the Amateur Owner Hunter sections. **Fence height:** 3'0" with spreads not to exceed the fence height. Courses will not be adjusted for ponies. In and outs will be permitted. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** Refer to HU166. **Awards:** Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: Adult Amateur Hunter 18- 39; Adult Amateur 40- 55; Adult Amateur 56 & over.

LOW ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER

Eligibility: Open to exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. **Cross Entry: Riders:** Riders may not cross enter into any class or section at the same competition where fences exceed 2'9". **Fence Height:** 2'6". In and outs will not be permitted. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** The Low Adult Amateur Hunter and Low Children's Hunter sections may be combined if there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. **Awards:** Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section: Low Adult Amateur Hunter.

AMATEUR JUMPER

Sections offered and requirements: 1.00/1.05m Amateur Jumper; 1.10/1.15m Amateur Jumper; **Cross Entry: Rider:** Riders may not show in any classes where the jumps exceed 1.20m. **Horse/Pony:** No cross entry restrictions. **Horse and Rider Combination:** 1.00/1.05m Amateur horse and rider combinations may not cross enter into the 1.10/1.15m Amateur Jumper section at the same competition. 1.10/1.15m Amateur horse and rider combinations may not cross enter into the 1.00/1.05m Amateur Jumper section at the same competition. **Fence Height:** 1.00m to 1.05m; 1.10m to 1.15m. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** Amateur Jumper sections may be divided by or combined with Junior Jumper sections, at competition management's discretion, if so stated in the prize list. **Awards:** Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: 1.00/1.05m Amateur Jumper; 1.10/1.15m Amateur Jumper

ADULT AGE GROUP EQUITATION SECTIONS

Sections Offered: Adult Equitation 18- 39; Adult Equitation 40- 55; Adult Equitation 56 & Over. **Cross Entry:** No cross entry restrictions into another section for horse and rider unless stated in the prize list. **Fence Height:** 2'9"- 3'6" with spreads not to exceed fence height. Combinations will be permitted. Management must state in the prize list, the height at which sections are being held. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** Refer to HU166. **Awards:** Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section: Adult Equitation 18- 39; Adult Equitation 40- 55; Adult Equitation 56 & Over.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE

Sections offered and requirements: Children's Hunter Horse 13 & Under; Children's Hunter Horse 14- 17. **Cross Entry: Rider:** Riders entered in the Children's Hunter section may not compete in the Junior Hunter section at the same competition. Riders may not show in any classes in which the fences are 3'9" and over at the same competition. **Horses/Ponies:** Horses entered in the Children's Hunter section may not compete in the Junior Hunter section at the same competition. **Horse and rider combination:** No cross entry restrictions. **Fence Height:** 3'0" with spreads not to exceed fence height. In and outs will be permitted. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** Refer to HU166. **Awards:** Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: Children's Hunter Horse 13 & Under; Children's Hunter Horse 14- 17.

LOW CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE

Eligibility: Open to exhibitors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. **Cross Entry: Riders:** Riders may not cross enter at the same competition into any class/ section where fences exceed 2'9". **Fence Height:** • 2'6". In and outs will not be permitted. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** The Low Children's Hunter and Low Adult Amateur Hunter sections may be combined if there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. **Awards:** Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section: Low Children's Hunter Horse.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY

Sections offered and requirements: Small/Medium Children's Pony; Large Children's Pony. **Cross Entry: Rider:** Children's Hunter Pony riders may compete on a maximum of one (1) Children's Hunter horse section at the same competition and in any class not to exceed 3'0" (Exception: Pony Jumpers). Green and Regular Hunter Pony riders may compete on a maximum of two (2) additional pony in the Children's Hunter Pony section at the same competition. **Horse/Pony:** Ponies may not cross enter into any other rated section at the same competition. **Horse and Rider Combination:** The same pony and rider may not cross enter into any other rated section at the same competition. **Fence Height:** In and outs will not be permitted. Classes may run as one or split Small/Medium and Large to run at 2'0" and 2'6" respectively. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** Refer to HU166. **Awards:** Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: Children's Hunter Pony-Small/Medium; Children's Hunter Pony-Large.

JUNIOR JUMPER

Sections offered and Requirements: 1.00/1.05m Junior Jumper; 1.10/1.15m Junior Jumper. **Entry: Rider:** Riders may not show in any classes where the jumps exceed 1.20m, except Junior riders competing in FEI Children's classes and USEF Talent Search Class. **Horse/Pony:** No cross entry restrictions. **Horse and Rider Combination:** 1.00/1.05m Junior horse and rider combinations may not cross enter into the 1.10/1.15m Junior Jumpers at the same competition. 1.10/1.15m Junior horse and rider combinations may not cross enter into the 1.00/1.05m Junior Jumpers at the same competition. **Fence Height:** 1.00m to 1.05m; 1.10m to 1.15m. **Combining/Dividing Sections:** Junior Jumper sections may be divided or combined with Amateur Jumper sections, at competition management's discretion, if so stated in the prize list. **Awards:** Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: 1.00/1.05m Junior Jumper; 1.10/1.15m Junior Jumper.

CHILDREN'S AGE GROUPS: HUNTER EQUITATION SECTIONS

Sections Offered: Hunter Equitation 11 & Under; Hunter Equitation 12-14; Hunter Equitation 15-17. **Cross Entry:** No cross entry restrictions into another section for horse and rider unless stated in the prize list. **Fence Height:** Hunter Equitation 11 & Under: Minimum 2'6", maximum 3' - management must state height at which class will be offered. Management may offer multiple height options if stated in the prize list, but each course must be set at the same height throughout. Combinations not permitted. Hunter Equitation 12- 14: Minimum 2'9", maximum 3'3" - management must state height at which class will be offered. Management may offer multiple height options if stated in the prize list, but each course must be set at the same height throughout. Combinations are optional. 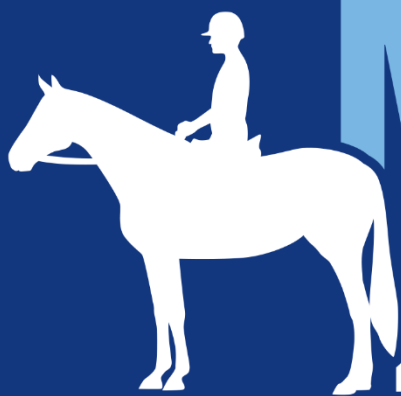

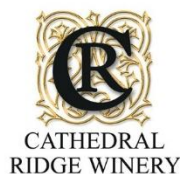
